The program aligns with current trends in educational innovation, addressing urgent needs for equitable digital teaching practices, inclusive learning design, and competency in emerging technologies.

Certificate Requirements

This fully online, graduate-level certificate program is designed for primary, secondary, and post-secondary educators. This 12-credit certificate program may be completed as a stand-alone certificate or completed as part of the stackable certificate-to-MA pathway; this certificate is stackable as part of the Master of Arts in Learning Design & Technology (LDT) or Master of Arts in Math Education. This certificate program can be started in any term and completed in one year.
