LEARNING DESIGN AND TECHNOLOGY, MA

Introduction

The courses in the Learning Design and Technology (LDT) MA program are fully online unless specified otherwise. Once admitted, students begin a plan of study that typically takes about two years to complete.

During the last semester of a MA program, students complete a professional portfolio, an online course project, or a thesis-type written project in lieu of a comprehensive exam. Each student seeking a MA in LDT will consult with their Faculty Advisor to determine which comprehensive project best meets your professional needs.

Program Requirements

Code Title Hours

Students complete one or two certificates from the Learning Design and Technology certificate options plus this required course for the MA:

INTE 6950 Experiential Thesis 3

Courses are offered only in certain semesters. Advising is recommended prior to enrolling in a course, even as a non-degree student, in order to ensure the most effective course sequencing and availability of courses.

The Learning Design and Technology, MA requires a total of 30 graduatelevel semester hours including INTE 6950 Experiential Thesis in the final semester. Course requirements for the 30 semester hours are as follows:

- Students select one or two certificates from the certificate options:

- INTE 6950 Experiential Thesis is a required course for the MA.
- Additional coursework to reach a total of 30 semester hours can be any graduate-level INTE course (INTE 6930 Internship: Learning Technologies is recommended) or from the Thematic Course Categories (https://education.ucdenver.edu/academic-services/ student-resources/thematic-course-categories/) with Faculty Advisor approval.
